Role Overview:

The Hynes Lakeview Volunteer Director is in charge of all PTO volunteer coordination and recognition of those who volunteer.

Duties of the Volunteer Director:

- Create and maintain sign ups for PTO and school volunteer needs, generally using Sign Up Genius.
- Keep track of volunteer hours for all PTO events and school requests and fulfill volunteer recognition programs.
 - Homework passes
 - Spirit Store credits
 - Mid-year volunteer communication
 - Super Volunteer breakfast and gift
- Gather contact information for grandparents for volunteering at PTO events and with coffee carts for teachers.
- Work with volunteer chairs for specific events to make sure they have what they need and help them with outreach and recruitment.
- Coordinate Whitney Wednesday volunteers

Duties of all PTO Officers:

- Prepare for and attend monthly PTO Officer meetings to plan for the month ahead. (Approximately 2 hours)
- Assist on site with major PTO Events (Back to School BBQ, Spooktacular, Fair, Gala, HMC Golf Tournament, etc.)
- Act as a liaison between families and Hynes school administration, surfacing areas of need the admin and/or PTO need to improve on.
- Attend bi-annual PTO Full Board meetings, voting on formal motions required by PTO bylaws. (Approximately 30-45 minutes)
- Assist in recruiting volunteers for all PTO related activities, from new officers to event team leads to day of volunteers.
