By May 2026...


- **K – 3 Literacy:** **88%** of K – 3rd grade students will score at or above benchmark on DIBELS or grow by one level.
- **Reading:** **88%** of K – 8th grade students will read on or above level or grow by one level according to the GATES MacGinitie reading Inventory and the ROOTS Reading Assessment.
- **3rd – 8th ELA:** **82%** of 3rd – 8th grade students will score STRONG overall performance on the ELA LEAP Assessment or meet their growth measurement target.
- **Math:** **70%** of 3rd – 8th grade students will score STRONG overall performance on the Math LEAP Assessment or meet their growth measurement target.
- **Science:** **60%** of 3rd – 8th grade students will score STRONG overall performance on the SCIENCE LEAP Assessment or meet their growth measurement target.
- **Social Studies:** **65%** of 3rd – 8th grade students will score STRONG overall performance on the S.S. LEAP Assessment or meet their growth measurement target.
