
# 25-26 Schoolwide Goals!

## By May 2026...

- **K – 3 Literacy: 88%** of K – 3<sup>rd</sup> grade students will score at or above benchmark on DIBELS or grow by one level.
- **Reading: 88%** of K – 8<sup>th</sup> grade students will read on or above level or grow by one level according to the GATES MacGinitie reading Inventory and the ROOTS Reading Assessment.
- **3<sup>rd</sup> – 8<sup>th</sup> ELA: 82%** of 3<sup>rd</sup> – 8<sup>th</sup> grade students will score STRONG overall performance on the ELA LEAP Assessment or meet their growth measurement target.
- **Math: 70%** of 3<sup>rd</sup> – 8<sup>th</sup> grade students will score STRONG overall performance on the Math LEAP Assessment or meet their growth measurement target.
- **Science: 60%** of 3<sup>rd</sup> – 8<sup>th</sup> grade students will score STRONG overall performance on the SCIENCE LEAP Assessment or meet their growth measurement target.
- **Social Studies: 65%** of 3<sup>rd</sup> – 8<sup>th</sup> grade students will score STRONG overall performance on the S.S. LEAP Assessment or meet their growth measurement target.
